SUMMARY

39,000 population, African Traditional Religion mixed with Islam, remote, some gospel recordings available, less than 100 known Christians

DETAILS

Who are they? The Toussian, also known as Northern Toussian, follow African Traditional Religion. They have an estimated population of 39,000.

What is their primary religion? African Traditional Religion

Where are they? The Northern Toussian are located north of Orodara in southwestern Burkina Faso.

Do they have a Christian witness? A local church has a vision to see the Northern Toussian reached, but further training is needed.

What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group?

- Oral recordings of gospel messages
- Local church interested in reaching the Toussian

Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group: An Engaging Church partner with the local church, Prayerwalking, providing training and discipleship and implementing Church planting strategies among the Northern Toussian.

What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people?

- Remote and primitive living conditions
- Lack of accessibility, especially during rainy season (May-October)

Specific Opportunities/Benefits:

- Local church interested in reaching the Northern Toussian
- Gospel Recordings in Northern Toussian
- Christians in Orodara (about 45 minutes from the Northern Toussian villages) who could be mobilized to reach out to the Northern Toussian
