### SUMMARY

2,000 population, Islam, remote locations, no known Christians, possible persecution for future believers

### DETAILS

**Who are they?** The Kubi have an estimated population of 2,000. Many Kubi speak Hausa and are losing their Kubi language.

**What is their primary religion?** Islam

**Where are they?** The Kubi can be found in Ganjuwa Local Government Area in Bauchi State. There is only one town and a few small villages.

**Do they have a Christian witness?** There are no known Kubi Christians. There are a few churches in the Kubi area, No known evangelical organizations are currently targeting the Kubi.

**What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group?** None.

**Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group:** An Engaging Church from the U.S.A. could begin targeting this people group. This church could work to partner with a Nigerian Baptist church in Bauchi.

**What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people group?**

- Teams would face remote and primitive living conditions.
- Education level is low requiring Gospel presentations to be done using oral methods.
- Care would have to be taken to witness to those following Islam in a way that would not bring persecution to them.

**Specific Opportunities/Benefits:**

- Gospel recordings are available in the Kubi language
- Other resources are available in Hausa, which many Kubi speak.
