DETAILS

Who are they? The Mandyak, also known as Manjaco, have an estimated population of 125,000.

What is their primary religion? African Traditional Religion

Where are they? The Mandyak can be found in the Cacheu region of Guinea Bissau.

Do they have a Christian witness? There are approximately 800 known Mandyak Christians. There is some church planting being done in the area where the Mandyak live, though the Mandyak are not being specifically targeted.

What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group? None

Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group: An Engaging Church from the U.S.A. could begin targeting this people group.

What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people group?

- Mandyak villages may be inaccessible during rainy season
- Strong attachment to African Traditional Religion
