Who are they? The Mankanya have an estimated population of 30,000

What is their primary religion? African Traditional Religion

Where are they? The Mankanya are found around Bula and Co

Do they have a Christian witness? There are approximately 60 known believers

What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group? Church planting, medical clinics

Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group: An Engaging Church from the U.S.A. is committed to engaging the Mankanya of Senegal. There are several churches in Guinea Bissau who have adopted the Mankanya. Based on this, there is no need for further engagement.

What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people group?

- Travel difficult in Guinea Bissau
- Village elders have said they want someone to work full-time with them to teach them
