20,000, Muslim mixed with African Traditional Religion

DETAILS

Who are they? The Dogosé are Muslims. They have an estimated population of 20,000.

What is their primary religion? Islam mixed with African Traditional Religion

Where are they? The Dogosé are in far southwest Burkina Faso in the Comoé Province.

Do they have a Christian witness? There are several churches in the Dogosé area but there are no Dogosé believers in them.

What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group? None

Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group: An Engaging Church could take the challenge of engaging the Dogosé with the Gospel. There are four neighboring groups who could also be engaged, the Komono, The Khe and the Dogosé Fing.

What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people?

- Remote and primitive living conditions
- Lack of accessibility, especially during rainy season (June - October)
- No scriptures available in language.

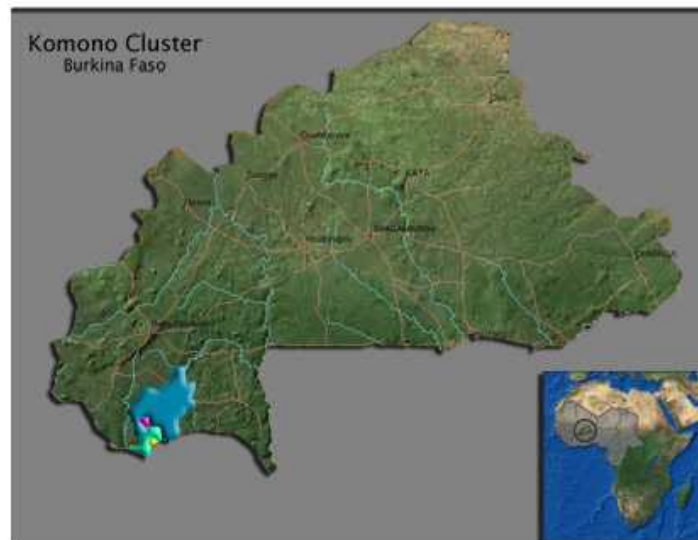
Specific Opportunities/Benefits:

- There are three Dogosé pastors who could help with ministry among their people
