### SUMMARY

10,000, Muslim, no churches among them

### DETAILS

**Who are they?** The Dogosé Fing are Muslims. They have an estimated population of 10,000, though this is hard to confirm because of the overlap with the Komono peoples.

**What is their primary religion?** Islam

**Where are they?** The Dogosé Fing are in far southwest Burkina Faso in the Comoé Province.

**Do they have a Christian witness?** There are several churches in the Dogosé Fing area but there are no Dogosé Fing believers in them.

**What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group?** None

**Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group:** An Engaging Church could take the challenge of engaging the Dogosé Fing with the Gospel. There are four neighboring groups who could also be engaged, the Komono, The Khe and the Dogosé. The Engaging Church could partner with the churches in the area.

**What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people?**

- Remote and primitive living conditions
- Lack of accessibility, especially during rainy season (June - October)
- No scriptures available in language.

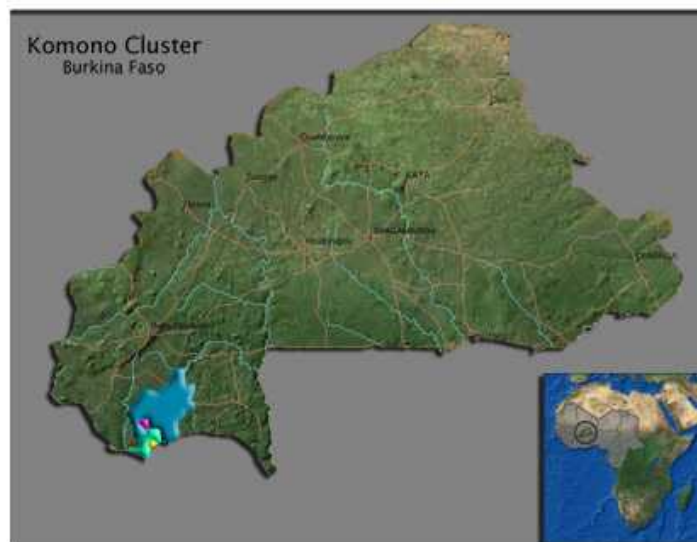
**Specific Opportunities/Benefits:**

- Almost all Dogosé Fing adults are bilingual in Jula
- SIL has established the need for a translation project, but it has not begun yet
