SUMMARY

105,000 population, Islam, remote locations, few known Christians, possible persecution for future believers

DETAILS

Who are they? The Konyanke have an estimated population of 105,000.

What is their primary religion? Islam

Where are they? The Konyanke can be found in the regions of Beyla and Nzerekore of Guinea. There are at least 14 villages made up primarily of Konyanke.

Do they have a Christian witness? There are approximately 12 known Konyanke Christians. Currently there is no translation work being done, but it is hoped the Jesus film will be produced soon in their language.

What strategies are being implemented for reaching this people group? None.

Suggestions and rationale for engaging this people group: An Engaging Church from the U.S.A. could begin targeting this people group.

What specific challenges or opportunities could directly affect the engagement of this people group?

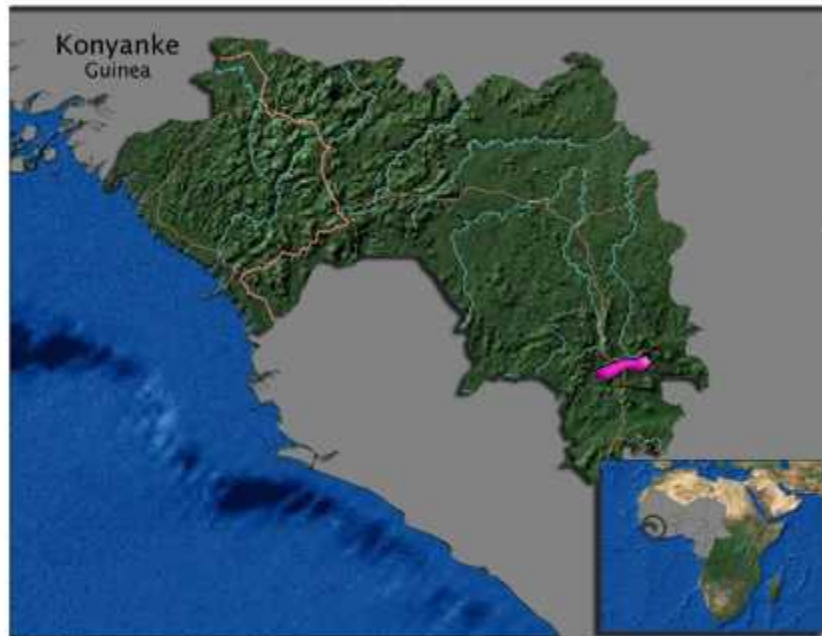
- Teams would face remote and primitive living conditions.
- Anyone targeting the Konyanke would need to learn their language.
- Care would have to be taken to witness to those following Islam in a way that would not bring persecution to them.
